



Feeding tours information

We are delighted to offer our wonderful feeding tours to our guests, here is some additional information regarding our feeding tour policy.

- From **19th July 2021**, in line with the latest Government guidelines, there are no restrictions on numbers gathering for the feeding tours, but we do ask that social distancing is observed with other families/ groups and the animal keepers.
- Adults must always accompany all children under 12 on the tour.
- Feeding tours take place at **8.30am** Monday – Saturday meeting near the wendy house in the toddler play area.
- We provide 1 bucket per child in your cottage, please bring them along to the tour each morning to feed the animals.
- Hand sanitiser is available throughout the tours we strongly recommend you use it, please ask the animal keeper during your tour.
- Some of our animals are not included on the feeding tour due to the small size of pens but you are very welcome to visit them another time during your stay.
- Our animal keepers are unable to help lift children into the pens. Please do not go into the pens or feed the animals without our keepers.
- Well behaved dogs are welcome on the tour (on leads!) and must be kept out of the pens.
- If any of your party are pregnant, please refer to the government guidance below
